## SENATE BILL NO. 250

Introduced by: Senator Kloucek and Representative Moore

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money for increased personal services for  
2 prison guards.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of two hundred  
5 thousand dollars (\$200,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of  
6 Corrections. The department shall award salary increases to prison guards in South Dakota penal  
7 institutions. The money shall be used to correct all past and present salary inequities between the  
8 guards at the South Dakota Penitentiary and other state penal institutions. Prison guards  
9 employed on or before November 22, 1993, who are not currently employed with a state penal  
10 institution are eligible for prorated benefits under this Act.

11 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Corrections shall approve vouchers and the  
12 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

13 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
14 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
