1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the circumstances under which a law enforcement
2 officer has a duty to report certain motor vehicle accidents.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-34-10 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-34-10. Every law enforcement officer shall, after receiving notice that an accident
6 described in § 32-34-7 occurred, cause a notice to be affixed in a manner prescribed by the
7 secretary of transportation to the vehicle damaged, indicating that the accident has been reported
8 ~~to him~~ and the circumstances surrounding the accident are being investigated. ~~The~~ If the accident
9 was the result of a moving violation or resulted in bodily injury or death, or if any party to the
10 accident cannot show proof of insurance or financial responsibility, the law enforcement officer
11 shall forward to the department of transportation, within three days after completion of the
12 investigation of the accident, an investigator's report of the accident so reported.
