1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow the shooting of coyotes from snowmobiles.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 32-20A-12 be amended to read as follows:

4 32-20A-12. No person may chase, drive, harass, kill or attempt to kill any game animal or
5 game bird with or from a snowmobile, except that coyotes may be taken by shooting from
6 snowmobiles through the use of firearms if the operator of the snowmobile is at least sixteen
7 years of age. No property owner or lessee is liable for any damages caused by or any injury to
8 any person who is engaged in taking or attempting to take coyotes from a snowmobile pursuant
9 to this section. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
