1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for legislative review of zoning ordinances if
2 there is a protest filed.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 11-4-5 be amended to read as follows:

5 11-4-5. If such an ordinance ~~be is~~ adopted, the ~~same~~ ordinance shall be published and take
6 effect as other ordinances unless the referendum ~~be is~~ invoked, or unless a written protest ~~be is~~
7 filed with the auditor or clerk, signed by at least forty percent of the owners of equity in the lots
8 included in any proposed district and the lands within ~~one~~ two hundred fifty feet from any part
9 of such proposed district ~~measured by excluding streets and alleys~~. A corporation shall be
10 construed to be a sole owner, and ~~when~~ if parcels of land are in the name of more than one
11 person, ownership representation shall be in proportion to the number of signers who join in the
12 petition in relation to the number of owners. ~~In the event such~~ If a protest ~~be is~~ filed, the
13 ordinance ~~shall~~ does not become effective as to the proposed district against which the protest
14 ~~has been filed. Such written protest shall not be allowed as~~ unless the ordinance is approved by
15 two-thirds of the governing body of the municipality. The protest provisions of this section do

1 not apply to any ordinance regulating or establishing flood plain areas.
