1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to regulate guided hunting activity on certain public lands.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 41-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 No person may guide any hunting activity on state-owned or managed game production
6 areas, state parks, recreation areas, and lakeside use areas, federal land leased or under
7 agreement to the state and managed for wildlife purposes, or private land leased or under
8 agreement to the department for the purpose of providing public access, or on highways or other
9 public rights-of-way within this state that otherwise meet the requirements of § 41-9-1.3, except
10 that a hunting guide or employees of a hunting guide may guide a hunting activity on the road
11 right-of-way immediately adjacent to property owned or leased by the hunting guide. A violation
12 of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.

13 Section 2. That chapter 41-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
14 follows:

1 For purposes of this Act, a hunting guide is a person who holds himself or herself out to the
2 public as a hunting guide and, for compensation or remuneration, directs or provides services to
3 any person for the purpose of hunting any wild animal.
