

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to provide rule-making authority to the Gaming Commission to establish the number of employees required on a premises with limited card games and slot machines.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 42-7B-40 be amended to read as follows:

42-7B-40. Any retail licensee under this chapter shall have at least one licensed employee that is at least twenty-one years of age on the premises or within a contiguous premises in full view and control of any limited card games or slot machines operated on the premises. The commission shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to establish the number of employees required to monitor the premises. The rules may also authorize the use of electronic devices or other types of monitoring equipment.
