1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide rule-making authority to the Gaming  
2 Commission to establish the number of employees required on a premises with limited card  
3 games and slot machines.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 42-7B-40 be amended to read as follows:

6 42-7B-40. Any retail licensee under this chapter shall have at least one licensed employee that  
7 is at least twenty-one years of age on the premises ~~and~~ or within a contiguous premises in full  
8 view and control of any limited card games or slot machines operated on the premises ~~pursuant~~  
9 ~~to the license obtained.~~ The commission shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to establish  
10 the number of employees required to monitor the premises. The rules may also authorize the use  
11 of electronic devices or other types of monitoring equipment.
