## HOUSE BILL NO. 1305

Introduced by: Representatives Jorgensen, Apa, Haley, Koetzle, and Matthews and Senators  
Dunn (Jim), Hutmacher, Shoener, and Valandra

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide rule-making authority to the Gaming  
2 Commission to establish the number of employees required on a premises with limited card  
3 games and slot machines.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 42-7B-40 be amended to read as follows:

6 42-7B-40. Any retail licensee under this chapter shall have at least one licensed employee that  
7 is at least twenty-one years of age ~~on the premises and within~~ in full view and control of any  
8 limited card games or slot machines operated on the premises ~~pursuant to the license obtained.~~  
9 The commission shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to establish the number of  
10 employees required to monitor the premises. The rules may authorize the use of electronic  
11 devices or other types of monitoring equipment.
