Introduced by: Senators Paisley, Brosz, Hunhoff, Lawler, and Morford and Representatives Roe and Haley

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to study the effects of video lottery and its repeal, to
2 prohibit the placement of additional video lottery machines, and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council shall retain an outside
5 neutral independent firm to study the effects that video lottery has had on the state and the
6 citizens of the state, to study the possible effects of a repeal of video lottery, and to study the
7 need to replace any revenues to the state if video lottery is repealed and, if necessary, to study
8 possible options for replacement revenue. The firm shall make a report of its findings and its
9 recommendations to the Executive Board prior to September 1, 1998. The Executive Board shall
10 appoint an interim legislative committee to review and evaluate the report.. All costs of retaining
11 an outside neutral independent firm shall be paid by the South Dakota Lottery from revenues
12 generated from the state's share of video lottery revenues.

13 Section 2. That chapter 42-7A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
14 follows:

1 No additional video lottery machines may be placed in any licensed establishment.

2 Section 3. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its

3 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full

4 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
