## SENATE BILL NO. 149

Introduced by: Senators Everist and Munson (David) and Representatives Brown (Richard),  
Cutler, Duniphan, and Jorgensen

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to contracting school  
2 districts that do not operate a K-12 school.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-15-14.2 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-15-14.2. Any school district that ~~enters~~ has entered into contractual agreements pursuant  
6 to § 13-15-1.3 or 13-15-11 ~~for the first time after July 1, 1989, shall within four years of~~  
7 ~~commencement of the contractual agreement, operate an elementary school and a secondary~~  
8 ~~school within the boundary of the school district, and does not operate an elementary school and~~  
9 ~~a secondary school within the boundaries of this state, shall~~ reorganize the school district  
10 pursuant to chapter 13-6 or adjust its taxation pursuant to §§ 13-11-9 to 13-11-11, inclusive.  
11 ~~Any school district that entered into a contractual agreement pursuant to § 13-15-1.3 before~~  
12 ~~July 1, 1989, shall within three years of July 1, 1990, operate an elementary school and a~~  
13 ~~secondary school within the boundary of the school district, reorganize the school district~~  
14 ~~pursuant to chapter 13-6 or adjust its taxation pursuant to §§ 13-11-9 to 13-11-11, inclusive~~  
15 within two years of July 1, 1998, with a school district within the boundaries of this state that

1 does operate an elementary school and a secondary school. Prior to reorganization required by  
2 this Act, any school district that has entered into a contractual agreement pursuant to § 13-15-  
3 1.3 or 13-15-11 shall adjust its taxation pursuant to §§ 13-11-9 to 13-11-11, inclusive. For the  
4 purposes of this Act, these provisions do not apply to a school district that operates  
5 cooperatively or under a contract with an agency of the federal government for a portion or all  
6 of its educational program located within the exterior boundaries of an Indian reservation.
