1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit any person under the age of eighteen to drive  
2 a motor vehicle after consuming alcoholic beverages.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 32-23 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 No person under the age of eighteen years may drive, operate, or be in actual physical control  
7 of any motor vehicle while consuming alcoholic beverages or with physical evidence of alcohol  
8 present in the person's body. When a person is found guilty of a violation of this section, the  
9 Unified Judicial System shall notify the Department of Commerce and Regulation. The secretary  
10 of the department shall revoke that person's driver's license or operating privilege for six months  
11 for a first offense or one year for any second or subsequent offense.
