1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain persons to take a driving test.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 32-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 Notwithstanding §§ 32-12-16 and 32-12-42, any person over the age of eighty renewing a
6 driver's license or being issued an original driver's license shall, upon meeting the requirements
7 of this section, receive a driver's license which expires two years after the person's ensuing
8 birthday. Each license shall be renewable one hundred eighty days prior to its expiration. Each
9 applicant shall successfully pass a test of the applicant's eyesight and successfully perform actual
10 demonstration of the applicant's ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the
11 operation of a motor vehicle prior to being issued a license or renewing a license. The fee for
12 such a license is two dollars.
