SENATE BILL NO. 28

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Health

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse a family physician
2 who has complied with the requirements of the South Dakota physician tuition
3 reimbursement program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of thirteen thousand
6 forty dollars (\$13,040), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Health
7 for the purpose of reimbursing a family physician who has, in the determination of the
8 department, met the requirements of the state physician tuition reimbursement program
9 established pursuant to § 1-16A-71.1.

10 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state
11 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

12 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
13 June 30, 1999, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
