1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the recording of a
2 social security number for the purposes of driver licensing and the titling and licensing of a
3 motor vehicle.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That chapter 32-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
6 follows:

7 In addition to the information required by § 32-12-3, every application under this chapter,
8 except for an application for a commercial driver's license, shall give the applicant the choice of
9 whether the applicant's social security number or some other distinguishing number assigned to
10 the applicant by the Department of Commerce and Regulation appears on the license. The choice
11 shall be made upon the initial application and upon any subsequent renewals of the license. The
12 Department of Commerce and Regulation shall prominently display a sign at any site accepting
13 applications under this chapter indicating that any applicant for a license can chose to have a
14 distinguishing number other than the applicant's social security number appear on the license.

1 Section 2. That § 25-7A-56.2 be amended to read as follows:

2 25-7A-56.2. To facilitate the collection of child support and to facilitate locating child
3 support obligors, the following information shall be recorded in the following manners:

4 (1) The social security number of any applicant for a professional license, commercial
5 drivers license, occupational license or marriage license shall be recorded on the
6 application. If an agency allows the use of a number, other than the social security
7 number as the license number, the agency shall advise the applicant;

8 (2) The social security number of any person who is subject to a divorce decree, support
9 order, paternity adjudication, or paternity acknowledgment shall be recorded on the
10 document relating to the matter;

11 (3) The social security number of any person who has died shall be placed in the death
12 records and recorded on the death certificate;

13 ~~(4) The social security number, drivers license number, or identification number of the~~
14 ~~owners shall be recorded in the records maintained by the Division of Motor Vehicles~~
15 ~~upon the issuance of the title or renewal of a registration.~~
