## SENATE ENGROSSED NO. **HB1004** - 3/4/99

Introduced by: Representatives Crisp, Derby, Fischer-Clemens, Konold, and Munson (Donald) and Senators Olson, Hutmacher, and Vitter at the request of the Interim Transportation Committee

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal performance-based budgeting.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 4-7-35 be repealed.

4 ~~—4-7-35. The Governor, through the bureau of finance and management, shall implement a~~  
5 ~~performance budgeting system that incorporates strategic planning and performance~~  
6 ~~measurements for all programs of state government including the board of regents and elected~~  
7 ~~officials' offices. The Governor may phase in the system over two years with all programs~~  
8 ~~included in the FY 1997 Budget Report presented to the 1996 Legislature.~~

9 Section 2. That § 4-7-36 be repealed.

10 ~~—4-7-36. The commissioner of the bureau of finance and management may promulgate rules~~  
11 ~~pursuant to chapter 1-26 to carry out the provisions of § 4-7-33.~~

12 Section 3. That § 4-7-37 be repealed.

13 ~~—4-7-37. The Legislature, through the executive board of the legislative research council, shall~~  
14 ~~implement a performance budgeting system for all of its programs.~~

15 Section 4. That § 4-7-38 be repealed.

1    ~~4-7-38. The unified judicial system shall implement a performance budgeting system for all~~  
2    of its programs.
