1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the membership on the Board of Economic
2 Development.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 1-16G-1 be amended to read as follows:

5 1-16G-1. There is created a Board of Economic Development and the Governor may appoint
6 up to thirteen members to consult with and advise the Governor and the Governor's
7 commissioner for economic development in carrying out the functions of the office. The
8 members of the ~~the~~ board shall be appointed by the Governor for four-year terms of office so
9 arranged that no more ~~that~~ than four members' terms expire in any given year. Not all members
10 may be from the same political party. At least three members shall be farmers or ranchers who
11 are actively engaged in farming or ranching, at least one member shall work in an agricultural
12 lending institution, and at least one member shall own or work in an agricultural business. The
13 Governor shall designate the terms at the time of appointment. Any member appointed to fill a
14 vacancy arising from other than the natural expiration of a term shall serve only the unexpired
15 portion of the term.
