## HOUSE BILL NO. 1147

Introduced by: Representatives Richter, Brown (Richard), Clark, Cutler, Engbrecht, Michels, Munson (Donald), Peterson, and Putnam and Senators Olson, Bogue, Dennert, Everist, and Reedy

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the construction of a new roof on the Dakota  
2 Dome at the University of South Dakota.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. It being declared to be in the public interest, the South Dakota Building Authority  
5 may contract for the construction of a new roof on the Dakota dome at the University of South  
6 Dakota at the estimated cost of eleven million five hundred five thousand dollars (\$11,505,000).  
7 The Building Authority may finance the project, including the issuance of revenue bonds, in  
8 accordance with this section and chapter 5-12. The Building Authority may not issue bonds for  
9 more than six million five hundred five thousand dollars (\$6,505,000) for the purposes of this  
10 Act.

11 Section 2. No indebtedness, bond, or obligation incurred or created under the authority of  
12 this Act may be or may become a lien, charge, or liability against the state of South Dakota, nor  
13 against the property or funds of the state of South Dakota within the meaning of the Constitution  
14 or statutes of the state.

15 Section 3. The Building Authority and the Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and  
16 expend any funds obtained for these purposes from federal sources, gifts, contributions, or any

1 other source, all of which shall be deemed appropriated to the project authorized by this Act.

2 Section 4. The administration of the design and construction of this project shall be under  
3 the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as provided in chapter 5-14.  
4 The executive director of the Board of Regents and the executive secretary of the Building  
5 Authority, or their designees, shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants  
6 to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

7 Section 5. The Board of Regents may make and enter into a lease agreement with the  
8 Building Authority and make rental payments under the terms thereof, pursuant to chapter 5-12,  
9 from funds obtained for such purpose and to support the construction, completion, furnishing,  
10 equipping, and payment of revenue bonds pursuant to this Act.
