1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions related to conflicts of interest
2 by school district personnel.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-20-2.1 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-20-2.1. No school district officer or employee may be interested in the sale, proceeds, or
6 profits of any book, apparatus, or furniture used or to be used in any school district of this state
7 in which the officer serves or the employee is employed. No officer or employee of the district
8 may engage in nor have a direct or indirect financial interest in any activity that conflicts or raises
9 reasonable question of conflict with their duties and responsibilities in the school system. No
10 such officer or employee may engage in work of any type if any information concerning
11 customer, client, or employer originates from any information available to them through school
12 sources. No such officer or employee may engage in work of any type and sell the product of
13 that work for profit to students. No such officer or employee may sell textbooks, instructional
14 supplies, reference books, equipment, student photographs, or items of clothing used by teams,
15 classes, or clubs or any other item or service to the students. A violation of this section is a Class
16 2 misdemeanor unless the sale is exempt as provided in § 6-1-2 or the purchase is made at public

1 auction.
