1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish the maintenance and repair fund for state dams
2 and to provide for its funding.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 38-7-25 be amended to read as follows:

5 38-7-25. There is hereby created a special fund known as the coordinated soil and water
6 conservation fund. All money in the coordinated soil and water conservation fund is dedicated
7 for the purposes identified in the South Dakota Coordinated Soil and Water Conservation Plan.
8 Interest earned on money in the fund shall be deposited in the fund. Annual revenue plus
9 investment earnings in excess of one million dollars shall be deposited in the maintenance and
10 repair fund for state dams created in section 2 of this Act.

11 Section 2. The maintenance and repair fund for state dams is established in the state treasury.
12 Interest earned on money in the fund shall remain in the fund. The fund shall be used to maintain
13 and repair dams on land owned by the State of South Dakota. Money in the fund shall be
14 budgeted and expended by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources based on
15 priorities for repair established through safety inspections conducted by the Department of
16 Environment and Natural Resources.

1 Section 3. The state treasurer shall transfer two hundred and fifty thousand dollars
2 (\$250,000) from the coordinated soil and water conservation fund to the maintenance and repair
3 fund for state dams.
