

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to revise the renewal fees for physicians, physician assistants, physical therapists, physical therapist assistants, medical corporations, and physician assistant corporations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 36-4-24.1 be amended to read as follows:

36-4-24.1. Each person receiving a license under the provisions of this chapter shall apply, on a form provided by the Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners, for a renewal of the license on or before the first day of March each year. The renewal shall be issued by the secretary upon payment of a fee to be fixed annually by the board, not exceeding the sum of two hundred dollars. The renewal shall be in the form of a receipt acknowledging payment of the required fee and signed by the secretary of the board.

Section 2. That § 36-4A-34 be amended to read as follows:

36-4A-34. The fees in connection with a certificate as a physician's assistant shall be as follows:

- (1) For certificate by examination, not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than seventy-five dollars;
- (2) For reexamination within one year, not less than fifteen dollars nor more than forty-five dollars;
- (3) For certificate by reciprocity, not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than seventy-five dollars;
- (4) For renewal of a certificate, not more than one hundred dollars;
- (5) For reinstatement of a certificate, not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars;
- (6) For reissuance of a lost or destroyed certificate, following approval of the board, ten dollars.

Section 3. That § 36-10-33 be amended to read as follows:

36-10-33. Any license issued by the board, pursuant to the provisions of this chapter, expires on the first day of January of the year next succeeding the issuance thereof. A license may be renewed upon the payment of a fee to be fixed annually, in rule, by the board not exceeding the sum of fifty dollars. Failure of a licensee to renew the license on or before the first day of July of each year shall constitute a forfeiture of the license. However, any person who has forfeited a license under this chapter may have the license restored by making written application therefor and by payment of the annual renewal fee for the current year.

Section 4. That § 47-11-12 be amended to read as follows:

47-11-12. Upon written application of the holder, accompanied by a fee of one hundred dollars, the Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners shall annually renew the certificate of registration if the board finds that the corporation has complied with its regulations and the provisions of this chapter.

Section 5. That § 47-11D-13 be amended to read as follows:

47-11D-13. Upon written application of the holder, accompanied by a fee of one hundred dollars, the board shall annually renew the certificate of registration if the board finds that the corporation has complied with its rules and the provisions of this chapter.
