## SENATE BILL NO. 58

Introduced by: The Committee on Health and Human Services at the request of the Department of Human Services

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain provisions regarding holiday compensation  
2 and vacation and sick leave of sheltered workshop employees of the Division of Service to  
3 the Blind and Visually Impaired.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 3-6-29 be repealed.

6 ~~—3-6-29. Sheltered workshop employees of the division of service to the blind and visually~~  
7 ~~impaired shall receive compensation for the same holidays as state employees under chapters 3-6~~  
8 ~~and 3-6A. Each sheltered workshop employee of the division shall earn five working days'~~  
9 ~~vacation time per full year of employment. Vacation hours are cumulative but may not exceed~~  
10 ~~ten days. Vacation hours earned may not be used until the employee has served an initial~~  
11 ~~six-month period. Each sheltered workshop employee of the division is also entitled to five days~~  
12 ~~leave of absence for sickness without loss of pay, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and holidays,~~  
13 ~~for each year he is in the employment of the workshop. Leave of absence for sickness is~~  
14 ~~cumulative but may not exceed ten days.~~
