SENATE BILL NO. 139

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish certain Legislative findings with regard to
2 Article XXIX, section 1 of the Constitution.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The Legislature finds that, in its judgment, public necessities require the
5 implementation of the provisions of Article XXIX, section 1 of the Constitution with regard to
6 packing houses.

7 Section 2. The Legislature further finds that the provisions of Article XXIX, section 1 may
8 be accomplished by means of joint ventures between private enterprises and the State of South
9 Dakota, by means of contracting for operational management, or by means of prepurchasing of
10 product.

11 Section 3. The Governor may implement the provisions of this Act by charging any state
12 agency in the Executive Branch with conducting feasibility studies, negotiations, and preparation
13 of contracts or legislation as may be appropriate.
