## SENATE BILL NO. 140

Introduced by: Senators Moore and Madden and Representatives Haley, Diedrich (Larry),  
Hagen, and Munson (Donald)

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to provide for an electronic voting  
2 machine in the senate chamber.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund, not otherwise  
5 appropriated, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, to the Legislative Research Council to provide for the purchase and  
7 installation of an electronic voting machine in the chamber of the South Dakota senate. Any  
8 funds not lawfully expended or obligated by June 30, 2000, shall revert to the general fund in  
9 accordance with § 4-8-21.

10 Section 2. The Legislative Research Council may accept and expend for the purposes of this  
11 Act, in addition to the amount in section 1 of this Act, any funds obtained from federal sources,  
12 gifts, contributions, or any other source if such acceptance and expenditure is approved in  
13 accordance with § 4-8B-10.

14 Section 3. Expenditures authorized by this Act shall be paid on warrants drawn by the state  
15 auditor on vouchers approved by the director of the Legislative Research Council.
