SENATE BILL NO. 209

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide certain incentives for school consolidation.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 13-13-1.4 be amended to read as follows:

4 13-13-1.4. If two or more school districts consolidate, for a period of ~~three~~ four years after
5 consolidation, the adjusted average daily membership for the newly formed district shall be based
6 upon the general enrollment average daily membership as defined in § 13-13-10.1 of ~~the~~ those
7 school districts that have not previously benefited from this section as they existed prior to
8 consolidation. In years two to four, inclusive, after the consolidation, the relationship between
9 the adjusted average daily membership and general enrollment average daily membership shall
10 be proportional to the relationship that existed for the first year.

11 Section 2. That chapter 13-13 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
12 follows:

13 In years five to eight, inclusive, after the consolidation of two or more school districts, the
14 adjusted average daily membership for the newly formed district shall be calculated as follows:

- 15 (1) Calculate adjusted average daily membership pursuant to § 13-13-10.1;
- 16 (2) Notwithstanding the four-year time limit, calculate adjusted average daily membership
- 17 pursuant to § 13-13-1.4;

- 1 (3) Subtract the results of subdivision (1) from the results of subdivision (2);
- 2 (4) Multiply the results of subdivision (3) by eighty percent in the fifth year, sixty percent
- 3 in the sixth year, forty percent in the seventh year, and twenty percent in the eighth
- 4 year;
- 5 (5) Add the results of subdivision (1) and the results of subdivision (4).
