SENATE BILL NO. 219

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make appropriations for a donation to the World War
2 II National Memorial and for commemorative memorials for persons awarded the
3 Congressional Medal of Honor and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of sixty-eight
6 thousand dollars (\$68,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of
7 Military and Veterans' Affairs to provide for a donation to the World War II National Memorial
8 in Washington, DC.

9 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of thirty-two thousand
10 dollars (\$32,000), to the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs to provide for establishing
11 public commemorative memorials for persons awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.

12 Section 3. The secretary of the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall approve
13 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

14 Section 4. The Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs may accept, transfer, and expend
15 any funds obtained for these purposes from federal sources, gifts, contributions, or any other
16 source, all of which shall be deemed appropriated to this purpose.

17 Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by

1 June 30, 2000, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.

2 Section 6. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
3 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full
4 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
