1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow a special fireworks sale period at the turn of the
2 millennium.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 34-37 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 Notwithstanding § 34-37-10, a person, firm, or corporation licensed pursuant to this chapter
7 to sell fireworks during calendar year 1999 may offer fireworks for sale to individuals at retail
8 for the period beginning at twelve a.m., December 24, 1999, and ending twelve a.m., January 2,
9 2000. The provisions of § 34-37-16.1 notwithstanding, fireworks that meet the requirements of
10 § 34-37-5 may be discharged during the period specified in this section. Such fireworks may not
11 be discharged during the period in any of the areas specified in § 34-37-11, except as provided
12 in § 34-37-11, nor in violation of any local government action prohibiting their use.
