1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt contracts for real estate or auction services from
2 competitive bidding procedures.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 5-18-18 be amended to read as follows:

5 5-18-18. The provisions of §§ 5-18-1 to 5-18-17, inclusive, do not regulate or apply to
6 contracts entered into and purchases made by the Department of Transportation or by the
7 Bureau of Administration or to the purchase of electric power, light, water, or gas; or any
8 municipal corporation for the purchase of materials, supplies, or equipment for any utility owned
9 or operated by such municipal corporation, if the purchase does not exceed the limits established
10 pursuant to § 5-18-3; or to contracts of any municipal corporation in time of war to acquire,
11 establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip, improve, maintain, operate, or regulate an airport
12 or landing field for the use of airplanes or other aircraft, of the United States armed forces or its
13 members, students, and mechanics; or to contracts of any public corporation for the purchase
14 of materials, supplies, or equipment from the United States or its agencies; or to equipment
15 repair contracts; or to the contracts of any school district, municipality, or county for the
16 purchase or lease of communications technologies, computers, peripheral equipment, and related
17 connectivity; or to the purchase of surplus property from another public corporation; or to the

1 purchase by one local government entity from the lowest responsible bidder of an item
2 competitively bid in the previous twelve months by itself or another local government entity or
3 the state at the bid price or less; or to animals purchased by a municipality for a zoo; or to
4 contracts for real estate services or auction services.
