1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money to expand the intensive juvenile
2 probation program of the Unified Judicial System.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the youth at risk trust fund the sum of five
5 hundred ten thousand dollars (\$510,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Unified
6 Judicial System to be used for the expansion of the intensive juvenile probation program.

7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated nine full-time equivalent positions to the Unified
8 Judicial System. These positions shall be juvenile intensive court services officers who will
9 provide intensive community-based individual and family supervision and services in
10 collaboration with state and local public and private service agencies.

11 Section 3. The state court administrator shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
12 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

13 Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
14 June 30, 2001, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
