1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require minimum training requirements for corrections
2 officers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The Department of Corrections shall develop and conduct a training program
5 based on training approved by a nationally recognized professional association for juvenile
6 correctional officers. The training program shall include:

7 (1) Goals;

8 (2) Objectives; and

9 (3) A curriculum outline which includes adolescent human behavior courses and gender
10 specific human behavior courses.

11 Section 2. The Department of Corrections shall develop and conduct a training program
12 based on training approved by a nationally recognized professional association for adult
13 correctional officers. The training program shall include:

14 (1) Goals;

15 (2) Objectives; and

1 (3) A curriculum outline which includes human behavior courses and gender specific
2 human behavior courses.

3 Section 3. The corrections commission created in § 1-15-1.13 shall review and approve the
4 training programs created in sections 1 and 2 of this Act by December 31, 2000.
