1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide a procedure for vehicle traffic when the traffic
2 control lights are malfunctioning or inoperable.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 32-28 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 If a traffic control signal is out of operation or is not functioning properly, the vehicle traffic
7 facing a:

8 (1) Green signal may proceed with caution as indicated in § 32-28-2;

9 (2) Yellow signal may proceed with caution as indicated in § 32-28-3; and

10 (3) Red or completely unlighted signal stop shall stop in the same manner as if the vehicle
11 is at a stop sign.
