1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain notice requirements for accidents involving
2 only damage to the motor vehicle of the driver.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-34-7 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-34-7. The driver of any motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in bodily injuries
6 or death to any person or property damage to an apparent extent of ~~five hundred~~ one thousand
7 dollars or more to any one person's property or ~~one two~~ thousand dollars per accident shall
8 immediately, by the quickest means of communication, give notice of ~~such~~ the accident to the
9 nearest available ~~peace~~ law enforcement officer who has jurisdiction. A violation of this section
10 is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
