## HOUSE BILL NO. 1230

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the maintenance and operation of certain boot  
2 camp programs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 26-11A be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read  
5 as follows:

6 Neither the Department of Corrections nor any other state or local agency may operate any  
7 boot camp or other correctional program that:

- 8 (1) Has military drill and ceremony as a component;
- 9 (2) Separates the participants from general population offenders;
- 10 (3) Accepts offenders under the age of eighteen; and
- 11 (4) Requires offenders to participate in a rigorous daily schedule of hard labor or physical  
12 training.
