1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit the sale of certain tobacco products from
2 displays that are accessible to the public.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 34-46 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 No person may offer for sale cigarettes packaged in units smaller than a carton containing
7 ten packages or single packages of smokeless tobacco in open displays which are accessible to
8 the public without the intervention of a store employee. This section does not apply to any retail
9 store which derives at least ninety percent of the store's revenue from tobacco and tobacco
10 related products.
