## HOUSE BILL NO. 1276

Introduced by: Representatives Napoli, Apa, Haley, Konold, Kooistra, Lucas, Nachtigal, Slaughter, Sutton (Daniel), Sutton (Duane), Volesky, and Young and Senators Staggers, Brosz, Flowers, Lange, and Symens

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish eligibility requirements for purchasers of houses  
2 constructed by prison inmates.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 11-11 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 Any individual person purchasing a house constructed by prison inmates under the  
7 Governor's housing program and sold through the South Dakota Housing Authority shall meet  
8 the following requirements:

- 9 (1) Is at least sixty-two years of age or is eligible to declare a disability as defined by the  
10 Social Security Administration;
- 11 (2) Agrees to use the house as the person's primary residence;
- 12 (3) Has a household income that does not exceed sixty-five percent of the median  
13 household income of the county where the person is placing the house; and
- 14 (4) Has a net worth that does not exceed a value that is twice the median household  
15 income of the county where the person is placing the house.

16 For the purposes of this section, median household income, is the median household income

1 established by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
