

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1002

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Endorsing and supporting the equal pay for equal work law.

WHEREAS, discriminatory practices by employers are prohibited under current South Dakota law; and

WHEREAS, § 60-12-15 of the South Dakota Codified Laws prohibits an employer from discriminating between employees on the basis of sex, by paying wages to any employee in any occupation in this state at a rate less than the rate at which the employer pays any employee of the opposite sex for comparable work:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-fifth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the Legislature urges all employers to abide by the equal pay for equal work law.
