1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Endorsing and supporting the equal pay for equal work
2 law.

3 WHEREAS, discriminatory practices by employers are prohibited under current South
4 Dakota law; and

5 WHEREAS, § 60-12-15 of the South Dakota Codified Laws prohibits an employer from
6 discriminating between employees on the basis of sex, by paying wages to any employee in any
7 occupation in this state at a rate less than the rate at which the employer pays any employee of
8 the opposite sex for comparable work:

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-
10 fifth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the Legislature
11 urges all employers to abide by the equal pay for equal work law.
