1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Supporting the designation of State Highway 34 as the
2 Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway.

3 WHEREAS, the Veterans of Foreign Wars celebrated their centennial year in 1999, and are
4 now commencing their second century of service to the community, state, and nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the designation of roadways to honor groups and individuals has become a
6 traditional practice and would in this instance be a fitting tribute to all South Dakota veterans
7 who served overseas during time of war; and

8 WHEREAS, the designation of State Highway 34 in South Dakota, with proper markers
9 installed and maintained, would remind the traveling public of the sacrifices made by these
10 veterans:

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-
12 fifth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the South
13 Dakota Legislature supports the designation of State Highway 34 in South Dakota from the
14 Minnesota border to the Wyoming border as the Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway
15 and requests the Transportation Commission to make such a designation and to provide for the
16 proper posting of the highway as a fitting means of honoring South Dakota's war-time veterans.
