1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require that firearms be cased and unloaded during the
2 crossing of certain private lands.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. No person who lawfully crosses private land on which the person does not have
5 permission to hunt in order to reach land on which the person is authorized to hunt may hunt on
6 the private land being crossed, and no such person while on the private land may carry or have
7 in possession any uncased firearm. Any firearm carried by or in the possession of the person
8 while on the private land shall be unloaded. Nothing in this Act authorizes any person to enter
9 onto private land for any purpose if the person is not otherwise authorized to do so.
