## SENATE BILL NO. 175

Introduced by: Senators Hutmacher, Bogue, Duxbury, Flowers, Lange, Moore, and Vitter and  
Representatives Nachtigal, Apa, Davis, Hanson, Kooistra, Sutton (Daniel),  
Volesky, and Weber

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish the Division of Antitrust Enforcement within  
2 the Office of the Attorney General.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 1-11 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 There is hereby established within the Office of the Attorney General the Division of  
7 Antitrust Enforcement. The attorney general shall appoint the director of the division. The  
8 division is subordinate to the attorney general and shall carry out orders and directives issued by  
9 the attorney general.

10 Section 2. That chapter 1-11 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
11 follows:

12 The Division of Antitrust Enforcement shall investigate all potential antitrust violations of  
13 the Constitution of the State of South Dakota and of the laws of this state, and shall place special  
14 emphasis on potential antitrust violations and unfair business practices in the agricultural sector.  
15 The attorney general may require the furnishing of any document or other record or evidence  
16 necessary to investigate such violations and practices and to carry out the purposes of this Act.

1 Section 3. That § 40-15B-6 be amended to read as follows:

2 40-15B-6. The attorney general and the Division of Antitrust Enforcement shall investigate  
3 and enforce the provisions of §§ 40-15B-1 to 40-15B-8, inclusive, and the Department of  
4 Agriculture shall refer any violations of these provisions to the attorney general. ~~The attorney~~  
5 ~~general or any person injured by a violation of these provisions may bring an action in circuit~~  
6 ~~court to restrain a packer from violating these provisions. A seller who receives a discriminatory~~  
7 ~~price or who is offered only a discriminatory price for livestock based upon a violation of these~~  
8 ~~provisions by a packer has a civil cause of action against the packer and, if successful, shall be~~  
9 ~~awarded treble damages.~~
