

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to allow the electronic storage of public records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 1-27-4 be amended to read as follows:

1-27-4. If any officer of the State of South Dakota, any political subdivision, municipal corporation, or public corporation is required or authorized by law to record, copy, file, recopy, or replace any document, plat, paper, voucher, receipt, or book on file or of record in the officer's office, the officer may do so by any photostatic, microphotographic, microfilm, mechanical, or electronic process which produces a clear, accurate, and permanent copy or reproduction of the original in accordance with the standards not less than those approved for permanent records by the national bureau of standards or the American National Standards Association.
