## SENATE ENGROSSED NO. **SB21** - 1/20/00

Introduced by: The Committee on Judiciary at the request of the Attorney General

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow for additional public distribution of sex offender  
2 information.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 22-22-34 be amended to read as follows:

5 22-22-34. The Division of Criminal Investigation may make the file available to any regional  
6 or national registry of sex offenders. The division shall accept files from any regional or national  
7 registry of sex offenders and shall make such files available ~~when~~ if requested pursuant to  
8 §§ 22-22-30 to 22-22-39, inclusive. For those registered offenders convicted of rape in the first  
9 degree or criminal pedophilia, the division may compile regional or statewide registration lists  
10 for public inspection as provided by chapter 1-27 or public distribution, including electronic or  
11 internet distribution.

12 Section 2. That § 22-22-40 be amended to read as follows:

13 22-22-40. Registration records collected by local law enforcement agencies pursuant to this  
14 chapter, registration lists provided to local law enforcement by the Division of Criminal  
15 Investigation, and records collected by institutions pursuant to § 22-22-38 for those persons  
16 required to register under the provisions of §§ 22-22-30 to 22-22-39, inclusive, are public  
17 records as provided in chapter 1-27. The registration list provided to local law enforcement shall

1 be a complete list of all sex offenders in the state and shall include the address of the sex offender  
2 and the sex crime the offender was convicted of.

3       Nothing in this section allows the release of the name or any identifying information  
4 regarding the victim of the crime to any person other than law enforcement agencies, and such  
5 victim identifying information is confidential.
