1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow certain children to be included as a level two, three,
2 four, or five disability for the purpose of calculating special education state aid.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-37-36.2 be amended to read as follows:

5 13-37-36.2. For the purpose of calculating state aid pursuant to this chapter, a level five
6 disability ~~must~~ shall meet criteria for at least two disability categories in levels two and three,
7 excluding the disability of deaf-blindness. ~~Any child reported on the child count between ages~~
8 ~~three to five years old, inclusive, may not be included as either a level two, three, four, or five~~
9 ~~disability.~~
