1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to change the expiration period for certain temporary
2 cosmetology permits.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-15-22 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-15-22. Any person who holds a current valid license, certificate, or certificate of
6 registration from another state or territory of the United States or from the District of Columbia
7 as an operator or manager-operator in the practices of cosmetology or as a nail technician or
8 manager-nail technician in the practice of nail care may apply to the commission for a temporary
9 permit to practice the art of cosmetology or nail care, as applicable, pursuant to the provisions
10 of this chapter. The application shall be accompanied with evidence satisfactory to the
11 commission that the applicant possesses those qualifications required pursuant to § 36-15-15 and
12 that the requirements of that state, territory, or district for licensure are comparable to the
13 requirements of this state for licensure. The application shall be accompanied with the fee
14 required by this chapter. A temporary permit ~~expires ninety days after issuance~~ is valid until the
15 date of the commission-scheduled examination in cosmetology or nail care, as applicable. If the
16 holder of a temporary permit takes the examination at the scheduled time, the commission shall

- 1 extend the temporary permit until the result of the examination is mailed to the applicant. If an
- 2 applicant fails the examination, the temporary permit is invalid and may not be extended or
- 3 reissued.
