## SENATE BILL NO. 65

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Department of Revenue to issue transporter  
2 plates for persons hauling new trailers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 32-9 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 Any commercial motor carrier located in the state hauling a new trailer with a manufacturer's  
7 statement of origin or manufacturer's certificate of origin and who has registered with the  
8 Department of Revenue as a transporter of new trailers may use a transporter plate to haul a new  
9 trailer upon the streets and highways for in-transit purposes. The fee for a transporter plate is  
10 fifty dollars and the fee shall be deposited in the license plate special revenue fund. Any new  
11 trailer with a transporter plate may be used to haul other new trailers. No transporter may use  
12 a transporter plate for any other purpose. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
