1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the issuance of a temporary permit during a
2 suspension of a restricted minor's permit to drive under certain conditions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 32-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 If a minor has a permit suspended for the first time pursuant to § 32-12-15 and the
7 suspension was not for a violation listed in subdivisions 32-12-49.1(1) to (8), inclusive, or for
8 a speeding violation, the department shall, if request by a parent or guardian, issue a temporary
9 permit to be used by the minor to drive a motor vehicle to and from school for school purposes
10 and for employment purposes during the period of suspension. If a minor is convicted of a
11 moving traffic violation while operating under the temporary permit or is found to be in violation
12 of the restrictions imposed by this section, the temporary permit may be canceled and the minor
13 is not eligible for another temporary permit.
