## HOUSE BILL NO. 1017

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Health

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse certain family  
2 physicians and certain physician assistants who have complied with the requirements of the  
3 South Dakota physician tuition reimbursement program or the South Dakota midlevel tuition  
4 reimbursement program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred  
7 eighty-two thousand one hundred eighty-seven dollars (\$182,187), or so much thereof as may  
8 be necessary, to the Department of Health for the purposes of reimbursing four family physicians  
9 and one physician assistant who have, in the determination of the department, met the  
10 requirements of the state physician tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-  
11 16A-71.1 and the midlevel tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-16A-73.6.

12 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state  
13 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

14 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
15 June 30, 2002, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
