1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require that certain state vehicles be equipped as flexible
2 fuel vehicles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. Any gasoline-powered motor vehicle that is purchased or leased by the state after
5 July 1, 2002, shall be equipped as a flexible fuel vehicle, also known as an FFV, if the cost of the
6 FFV is less than or equal to the cost of a conventional gasoline powered vehicle and if the FFV
7 otherwise meets the same specifications as the state requires for conventional gasoline powered
8 vehicles. For purposes of this section, the term, flexible fuel vehicle or FFV, means a vehicle that
9 is capable of using a variety of ethanol blend motor fuels, including E85 as defined in § 10-47B-
10 3.
