## HOUSE BILL NO. 1111

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow certain persons to teach secondary education  
2 without a teaching certificate.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 13-42 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as  
5 follows:

6 A person may teach secondary education in that person's field of study or experience in any  
7 public or nonpublic school without a teaching certificate required by chapter 13-42 if that person  
8 meets one of the following qualifications:

- 9 (1) Holds a master's or doctoral degree awarded by an accredited graduate program; or  
10 (2) Holds a bachelor of arts or bachelor of science degree and has at least ten years of  
11 work experience in a field relating to the subject to be taught.
