1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to remove the fee for special vehicle license plates for
2 firefighters.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-5-113 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-5-113. Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a resident of this state, who is a firefighter
6 and who has complied with all of the laws of this state in relation to the registration of a motor
7 vehicle, may receive plates bearing a distinctive number and design, and designating such person
8 as a firefighter. Such number plates shall be designed by the fire marshal and subject to the
9 approval of the Department of Revenue. The distinctive plates shall be in addition to the regular
10 number plates issued for the motor vehicle pursuant to § 32-5-98. The distinctive plates shall be
11 displayed as set forth in § 32-5-98 and the regular number plates shall be kept on or in the motor
12 vehicle. No license fee may be charged for the distinctive plates and for the distinctive plates'
13 renewal stickers.

14 Section 2. That § 32-5-114 be repealed.

15 — ~~32-5-114. Each person receiving firefighter distinctive number plates shall pay a fee therefor~~

1 ~~which shall be fixed by the Department of Revenue so as to reimburse the State of South Dakota~~
2 ~~for the cost of producing such special number plates. All fees collected under this section shall~~
3 ~~be placed in the license plate special revenue fund, as provided under § 32-5-67.~~
