1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase an appropriation from the children's trust fund
2 and to repeal a statute that terminates an additional charge for birth records that is deposited
3 in the fund.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 26-14-3 be amended to read as follows:

6 26-14-3. There is hereby annually appropriated ~~the sum of sixty thousand dollars~~ to the
7 Department of Social Services from the children's trust fund fifteen percent of the fund balance
8 as of the first day of the prior fiscal year. The funds so appropriated may be used with any other
9 money otherwise annually appropriated or contributed to nonprofit organizations to establish or
10 continue community-based education programs to prevent the occurrence and recurrence of child
11 abuse and neglect. The department may not assess administrative fees or charges against the
12 fund. ~~No money may be appropriated from the children's trust fund unless there is at least sixty~~
13 ~~thousand dollars in the fund.~~

14 Section 2. That § 26-14-4 be repealed.

15 ~~26-14-4. If the fund exceeds one million dollars, the additional charge for supplying a~~

1 ~~certified copy of the record of any birth shall be terminated.~~
